I would like to thank everyone for attending the 2010 NSSA World Skeet Championships. A hearty welcome is extended to our competitors, referees, vendors, volunteers and guests from your NSSA staff, officers and directors. We sincerely hope that your experience at the 75th NSSA Annual Skeet Championships will be a memorable one and that you will return in future years.

The World Skeet Championships brings you to San Antonio, a great city to explore along with good shooting at the National Shooting Complex (NSC) with friends and family. This year, we have enhanced the Mini World program with three flights of Mini World Doubles scheduled for Friday. We have also scheduled two of the popular 4x50 target events on Thursday and Friday before the Mini, a perfect way to get warmed up on the Championship fields. This year, the World Shoot Main Event has been shortened by one day; the Monday 12 gauge event consists of 75 targets shot in the morning (East) and 75 targets shot in the afternoon (West). There will be four flights in the Main Events again this year providing more daylight at the end of the shooting day for shoot-offs. We have German silver belt buckles for all First in Class in each event which we intend to present in the stadium field each evening. There will also be plenty to do at the National Shooting Complex. 5-Stand and Sporting Clays competitions will be available for your enjoyment as will the chance to shoot additional targets during the World Shoot, beginning on Monday. The Hall of Fame Banquet is scheduled for Tuesday evening this year, after the 20 gauge shoot-offs and is always a good time; I hope you plan to attend and support our Hall of Fame inductees. And, don't forget the party for all the shooters, scheduled this year for Wednesday evening as shoot-offs wind down at the Main Club house and along Vendor Row.

While you're here, take the opportunity to visit Vendor's Row. One of the unique aspects of the World Shoot is the variety and availability of shooting-related products. Manufacturers and vendors of the best shooting products from afar relocate to the National Shooting Complex for the eight days of the Mini World and World Skeet Championships. Shooters can rent practice fields Wednesday and Thursday so that they can practice at their discretion. A field can be rented for \$200 for a single day or \$300 for two days. Contact Phyllis Mills for further information.

### SHOTGUN STORAGE

Secure shotgun storage is available on the National Shooting Complex grounds. Storage tickets may be purchased from the Ammo Building Cashier. Check-in and out of guns is through the Shotgun Storage entrance or the Ammo Building Cashier depending on time of day. A NSC employee will be on duty to check your shotgun in and out as needed. For \$5 a day per gun case, no more than two guns per case, you can rest easy knowing that your gun is safely stored in an insured building instead of in the back of your vehicle.
